Our History


Sce LifeWorks was founded in the mid-1980's by parents of individuals who lived with intellectual disabilities. Dissatisfied with the range of existing options for their sons and daughters, they had a dream of alternative services which would not only provide their children with opportunities and participation in mainstream life, but which would support people in contributing their own skills, abilities and resources to society.

This dream, combined with hard work, resulted in the establishment of Sce LifeWorks (then called Sturgeon Creek Enterprises). Today, Sce LifeWorks is in partnership with hundreds of businesses and supports over 135 individuals throughout the city of Winnipeg in achieving their personal goals.

Providing Support

Working together with families, businesses, and the community, Sce LifeWorks supports people throughout the city of Winnipeg with intellectual disabilities who have a range of abilities and support needs. We pride ourselves on providing reliable, flexible and individualized supports tailored to the person and their individual plan for life.
